National Disaster Management Authority (NDMA) and National Institute of Disaster Management (NIDM) are observing the day on 10th October, 2012 focusing national attention on the issue of 'school safety'.



WHY IS SCHOOL SAFETY CRITICAL?

Hundreds of school children are affected almost every year by natural/manmade disasters.

- ★ The 2001 GUJARAT EARTHOUAKE is believed to have KILLED 971 STUDENTS
 - and **31 TEACHERS**; with **1,884 SCHOOL BUILDINGS COLLAPSING**
- *** KUMBAKONAM FIRE** tragedy **KILLED 94 CHILDREN** in 2004
- * BUS FALLING into YAMUNA RIVER in North Delhi KILLED 24 CHILDREN in 1997
- ★ DABWALI FIRE tragedy KILLED more than 100 CHILDREN in 1995

This makes it imperative to reduce school vulnerability through both structural and non-structural interventions.
